Oberammergau 2020 – 30 August for 7 nights

Stella Noons of St Edmund's Taverham (where Simon and Emma moved from) is organising a group to see the Passion Play in Oberammergau in 2020 and has sent us the information in case anyone would like to join them.

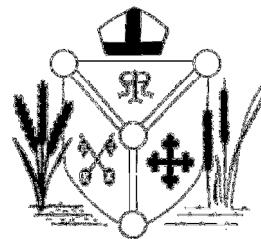
The trip is organised by 'Tailored Travel'. The tour involves flying to Munich from either Stansted or Luton (depending on which they find to be the best options nearer the time). Private transfer to the airport would be arranged at an extra cost.

The cost for those sharing a room is £1,239. There is a £89 supplement for a single room (available other than for the night in Oberammergau).

For those who might not want to fly there could be the possibility of making your own way to Munich by rail or road. Tailored Travel say that several people have done that and joined the tour in Munich. They would simply cut the airfare from the cost.

Deposits: If you are interested you would need to pay a deposit of £150 by the end of October this year and then a further deposit of £250 on 31 January 2019. The full balance would be payable two months before departure.
