Opportunities to see the Archbishop of Canterbury in our Diocese:

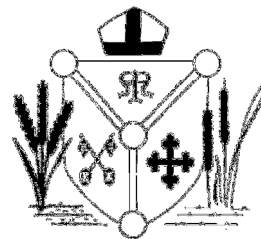
'Reflections on Reconciliation' Weds 7 Nov, 7pm-9pm, Norwich Cathedral

This will be opening contributions from a richly diverse panel chaired by Bishop Graham speaking about the need for reconciliation in a world peopled by homeless refugees and also in a divided Church. The Archbishop will make a presentation before leading us into a time of silence and prayer. There will then be time for people to make their pilgrimage around Stations of Reconciliation before Compline by candlelight. There is also an evensong at 5.30pm as well as the opportunity to explore the Stations of Reconciliation at 6.30pm. Free - no booking is required.
