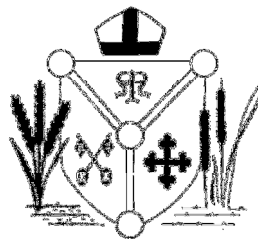

Iona is a small island off Mull in Scotland, and has a long association with Christianity. As well as services at Bishop's House there is opportunity to go to the famous Iona Abbey, and there are other churches on the island. There are a number of shops, and despite Iona's small size, plenty of walking!

The cost of the week is £470 - this includes full board at Bishop's House, but does not include travelling. Most people tend to drive, but train or coach travel are both possible.
