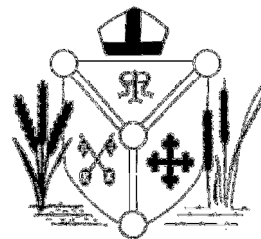
A Prayer for Andrew as he prepares for Ordination
